Our Commitment to Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. To better protect your privacy we provide this notice explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used. To make this notice easy to find, we make it available on our homepage and at every point where personally identifiable information may be requested.

The Information We Collect

This notice applies to all information collected or submitted on our website. There will be different privacy policies in effect for pages which link to or from this page (for example, the page where you may open a checking account). On our website, you can make requests for information and register to receive materials. The Way We Use Information

We do not share this information with other outside parties except to the extent necessary to serve you (for example, if we are facilitating your opening a checking account with one of our banking partners, we will provide your information to that banking partner or to the online account opening service to allow them to open an account you have requested be opened).

We use non-identifying and aggregate information to better design our website and to share with our program sponsors. For example, we may use statistics that a certain number of individuals visited a certain area on our website, or that our average age of applicants is a certain number. Finally, we never disclose the personally identifiable information provided to us online to others except as described above without also providing you an opportunity to opt-out or otherwise prohibit such disclosure.

Our Commitment to Data Security

To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Our Commitment to Children's Privacy

Protecting the privacy of minors is especially important. For that reason, we never collect or maintain information at our website from those we actually know are under 18, and no part of our website is structured to attract anyone under 18. The terms and conditions of our programs expressly prohibit participation by individuals less than 18 years of age.

How You Can Access or Correct Your Information
